Project Objectives:-

- Marginalized section children/girls and women are mainstreamed socially/educationally/economically through involving them with livelihood based income generating activities, vocational/technical training courses, supplementary education, care and psycho-social support.
- Situational sensitivity and self defense mechanism are developed among adolescent/girls/children through liaison them with different kind of information relating to their surrounding environment.
- Co-ordination and convergence with multi- level stakeholders are strengthened more for promotion and protection of the girl child rights and dignity- before and after birth.

Project Strategies

- Develop individual plans for each vulnerable girl/woman and their families to reduce their vulnerability from gender biased violence.
- They will develop an understanding about their rights, particularly to education and protection from all forms of abuse, and then demand these rights
- Adolescent Participation and leadership building
- Strengthen community based structures in each village involving PRI members that would work as watch dogs to reduce the vulnerability of girls/children/women.
- Ensure the regular livelihood education of the girls to complete primary and higher education.
- Strengthen livelihood opportunities for girls/women to make them economically independent
